Exchange students have several options for housing in Raleigh. On-campus housing requires an application through MyPack Portal.

NCSU has instituted a new first year live on requirement. All first year students are given priority for housing assignments. For this reason some of their exchange students may not receive an assignment on-campus. Students should complete the housing application in a timely manner and also consider off

campus accommodations. NCSU office has identified some off campus apartment complexes that are a good fit for exchange students.

In addition to this students are also encouraged to apply to live in villages. There is a SEPARATE application to live in a village and they recommend that students take the application seriously. Please remind NCSU cannot guarantee on campus housing or housing in the Global Village. NCSU office is dedicated to help all students find accommodations during their exchange program.
