Insurance information

It is mandatory for all Exchange students to be covered by health insurance for the entirety of your study at UTA. The UT Student Health Insurance Plan (UT SHIP) provides the needed coverage.

Enrollment in UT SHIP is automatic each semester and the insurance premium is automatically charged to your tuition and fee account when you register for classes. As an Exchange student, you only have to purchase the plan for the semester(s) that you will be attending UTA. Please note that you will not be able to register for class until you show proof of insurance.
