Academic Information for Course Selection

Course selection:

Depending on the semester, the student may only choose courses from the odd semester (1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Semester) or from the even semester (2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Semester).

The selected courses must appear in the application form has to be uploaded to the platform. UCEN provides the possibility for students to be able to choose courses from different majors.
